



The Truth About The New Creature

- iv. The new things are from God. So don't accept anything that isn't from Him. Failure isn't from God. Sickness isn't from God. Accept only the things that come from God – all good and perfect things! (James 1:17)
- v. The Lord didn't just save you and bring you close to Himself; He also gave you the work of helping others get saved too.

- vi. Your salvation is by God's grace. No person made you worthy of it, and no one can take it away from you (Romans 5:17, Ephesians 2:4-5; Romans 3:24).
- vii. You now have plenty of grace to enjoy a beautiful life and rule in life through Jesus Christ (Romans 5:17).
